#### 1. Summary of Significant Account Policies and Going Concern

#### A. Accounting Practices

The accompanying financial statements of the Nassau Life Insurance Company of Kansas ("NKS" or the "Company") have been prepared in conformity with accounting practices prescribed or permitted by the State of Kansas Department of Insurance (the "Department").

For determining the Company's solvency under the State of Kansas's insurance laws and regulations, the Department recognizes only statutory accounting practices prescribed or permitted by the State for determining and reporting the financial condition and results of operations of the Company. The State of Kansas has adopted the National Association of Insurance Commissioners' ("NAIC") *Accounting Practices and Procedures Manual* ("NAIC SAP"), version effective January 1, 2001, NAIC SAP as a component of practices prescribed or permitted by the State of Kansas. The Insurance Commissioner has the authority to prescribe or permit other specific practices that deviate from prescribed practices. As of June 30, 2025, the Commissioner had not prescribed or permitted the Company to use any accounting practices that would result in the Company's earnings or financial position to deviate materially from NAIC SAP.
